CURRENT FIRE WEATHER FOR LAS VEGAS, PHOENIX, FLAGSTAFF, AND TUCSON

LAS VEGAS WEATHER DISCUSSION

SYNOPSIS...SCATTERED THUNDERSTORMS WITH LOCALLY HEAVY RAINFALL REMAIN A THREAT OVER THE EASTERN MOJAVE DESERT...SOUTHERN NEVADA AND NORTHWEST ARIZONA TODAY. DRY AND STABLE AIR PUSHING ACROSS THE SOUTHERN SIERRA AND WESTERN MOJAVE DESERT WILL BRING A GRADUAL DRYING TREND WITH DECREASING THUNDERSTORM COVERAGE FROM WEST TO EAST MONDAY AND MOSTLY DRY WEATHER TUESDAY THROUGH THURSDAY.

FLAGSTAFF WEATHER DISCUSSION

SYNOPSIS...A VERY MOIST AND UNSTABLE AIRMASS ACROSS ARIZONA WILL BRING NUMEROUS SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS TO THE REGION TODAY... SOME PRODUCING VERY HEAVY RAINFALL.

PHOENIX WEATHER DISCUSSION

MONSOONAL MOISTURE WILL REMAIN ACROSS THE DESERT SOUTHWEST...HOWEVER STEADILY DECREASE THROUGH MIDWEEK. CORRESPONDINGLY...RAINFALL CHANCES WILL ALSO DECREASE THOUGH TEMPERATURES SHOULD STAY BELOW AVERAGE. THE BELOW-AVERAGE RAIN CHANCES WILL LARGELY PERSIST THROUGH THE END OF THE WEEK WITH A GENERAL WARMING TREND...THOUGH MOISTURE MAY TRY TO START WORKING WESTWARD INTO THE AREA BY THE WEEKEND.

TUCSON WEATHER DISCUSSION

SYNOPSIS...ABUNDANT MOISTURE WILL RESULT IN SCATTERED SHOWERS AND THUNDERSTORMS THROUGH MONDAY. SOMEWHAT DRIER AIR WILL MOVE INTO THE AREA BY MIDWEEK FOR DECREASING PRECIPITATION CHANCES. SCATTERED MAINLY AFTERNOON AND EVENING THUNDERSTORMS WILL THEN RETURN BY NEXT WEEKEND.
