Current Fire Activity

Saturday August 11, 2012 0800
(Report covers previous 24 hours)

Statewide Weather Brief: The strong high pressure above Arizona is expected to remain the dominant weather feature into the weekend. Exceptionally hot temperatures are expected to continue through this period. Daytime humidity values will be in the low teens. Isolated and scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected to develop across regions of higher elevation. Winds will be light and diurnal except near thunderstorms where they can be gusty and erratic.


