Current Fire Activity

National Preparedness Level: 1
Southwest Area: 3 Arizona Forestry: 3

Statewide Weather Brief: Near seasonal temperatures throughout Arizona today. Breezy conditions and low relative humidities will remain throughout the state, but are not expected to reach Red Flag Warning thresholds. Cooler temperatures are forecasted starting Sunday into mid-week.

Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity: ADC dispatched resources to 4 wildfires and 1 smoke check, and transferred 1 mineshaft fire to Tucson Dispatch. ASFD Escudilla crew continues to check on the Red Bird incident.


