Statewide Weather Brief: A dry and westerly flow with breezy and cloudy conditions. Relative humidities will remain low, but are not expected to reach red flag warning conditions. There is a slight chance of scattered thunderstorms on Tuesday.

Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity: ADC dispatched resources to 1 wildfire and 1 smoke report, and transferred 1 fire to Prescott Dispatch.

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
