EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Current Fire Activity

June 6, 2013 0800 hrs
(Report covers previous 24 hours)

National Preparedness Level: 2
Southwest Area: 4 Arizona Forestry: 3

Statewide Weather Brief: A few high based thunderstorms may develop again today over the mountain areas of northern Arizona. Storms that do develop will be capable of producing erratic winds. Southeastern Arizona is forecasted to be hot and dry through the week with a slight chance of thunderstorms Friday afternoon and evening near the White Mountains along the New Mexico border.

Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity: ADC dispatched resources to 3 wildfires and 1 smoke check. ADC transferred 1 wildfire report to Tucson Dispatch, 2 reports to Phoenix Dispatch and 1 report to Color Country Dispatch. Resources have been dispatched to California and New Mexico.


