Current Fire Activity

Statewide Weather Brief: Red Flag Warning in effect for strong winds and low relative humidity from 11 am to 8 pm this evening in Coconino, Mohave, Navajo, and Yavapai counties. Low relative humidities will be in the single digits to low teens across the state. There is a small chance of thunderstorms over the mountain areas throughout southern Arizona this weekend.

Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity: ADC dispatched resources to 6 wildfires and 4 smoke checks. ADC transferred 1 wildfire report to Tucson Dispatch. Resources have been dispatched to California and New Mexico.


