National Preparedness Level: 2
Southwest Area: 4 Arizona Forestry: 3

Statewide Weather Brief: Red Flag Warning from noon today until 9 pm tomorrow for strong winds and low relative humidity for Mohave County. There is also a Red Flag Warning from 1 pm to 8 pm today for strong winds and low relative humidity in Coconino County. Temperatures throughout the central deserts are expected to peak and possibly exceed 110 degrees today. There is a slight chance of thunderstorms expected east of Tucson on Thursday and Friday.

Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity: ADC dispatched resources to 3 wildfires and 1 smoke check. Resources have been dispatched to California and New Mexico.


