



# ARIZONA STATE FORESTRY DIVISION EXECUTIVE SUMMARY Current Fire Activity



October 11, 2013 0800 hrs  
(Report covers previous 24 hours)

**National Preparedness Level: 1**  
**Southwest Area: 1 Arizona Forestry: 1**

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Arizona received approximately 100 lightning strikes (approximately 10 positive) in the last 24 hours. The strong upper level low that brought much cooler temperatures and scattered showers to the region yesterday will move into the Central Plains today. In its wake, expect another day of below normal temperatures and sunny skies throughout central Arizona. Dry conditions, with a slow warming trend, are expected this weekend through at least the end of next week in southeastern portions of the state. Warmer and more pleasant weather is in store for northern Arizona through Saturday.

**Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity:** ADC received no wildfire reports.


