## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

### Current Fire Activity

June 17, 2013 0800 hrs  
(Report covers previous 24 hours)

**National Preparedness Level: 2**  
**Southwest Area: 4 Arizona Forestry: 4**

**Statewide Weather Brief:** Hot and dry conditions will prevail through the middle of the week. For Wednesday through Friday, a pacific trough will move in west of Arizona bringing an increase of wind speeds with dry conditions. Afternoon winds will approach critical fire weather thresholds by Wednesday north of the Mogollon Rim.

**Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity:** ADC dispatched resources to 2 wildfires and 4 smoke checks. Resources have been dispatched to Colorado, New Mexico, and Utah.


