Current Fire Activity

June 13, 2013 0800 hrs
(Report covers previous 24 hours)

National Preparedness Level: 2
Southwest Area: 4 Arizona Forestry: 4

Statewide Weather Brief: Red Flag Warning from noon today until 8 pm for portions of Coconino and Navajo counties for strong winds and low relative humidities. There is a slight chance for afternoon and evening thunderstorms across the higher terrain east of Tucson today and Friday. Temperatures throughout the central deserts are expected to peak and possibly exceed 110 degrees today. Dry weather will continue through the end of the week.

Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity: ADC dispatched resources to 3 wildfires and 3 smoke checks. Resources have been dispatched to Colorado and New Mexico.


