Current Fire Activity

May 28, 2013 0800 hrs

National Preparedness Level: 1
Southwest Area: 3 Arizona Forestry: 3

Statewide Weather Brief: Red Flag Warning in effect from 11:00 am to 8:00 pm for strong and gusty southwest winds and low relative humidities. These conditions will result in high fire danger. The affected counties are: Apache, Cochise, Coconino, Graham, Greenlee, Navajo, Pima, Pinal, and Santa Cruz.

Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity: ADC dispatched resources to 2 wildfires and transferred 1 fire to the Color Country Dispatch for the Arizona Strip, 1 fire to Flagstaff Dispatch for the Coconino NF, and 1 to Phoenix Dispatch for the Tonto NF.

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
