Statewide Weather Brief: Warm dry conditions continue today as high pressure strengthens through the region. A Red Flag Warning is in effect from 2 pm to 8 pm for the Black Mesa and Chuska Mountains on the Navajo Nation due to strong winds and low relative humidity.

Arizona Dispatch Center (ADC) Activity: ADC had 2 new fires for 40.1 acres and 2 smoke reports yesterday.


